APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Thank you for your interest in the International Alliance For Invitational Education and the *Inviting School Award* program. We appreciate your interest and encourage you to participate. In an effort to ensure that schools intending to apply have sufficient time to complete the required work, it is suggested that the "Acceptance Verification" form be signed and returned by the target date of October 1, 2009. Each school/district/university applying for the *2010 Inviting School Award* will then submit your school's supporting documentation to the Chair by March, 2010.

Please display the portfolio contents in a THREE RING BINDER consisting of no more than 50 pages, or if you choose, in a power point presentation format on a CD Rom (no more than 50 slides). You may choose to have a decorative cover which "tells your story." The portfolio contains, but is not limited to the following information:

1. **COVER PAGE:** Name of school/district/university
Type (Elementary, Middle, High School, Technical, Junior College, etc.)
Contact name, address, phone, email address
Mascot (optional)
2. **SIGNATURE PAGE OF INTENT FOR APPLICATION FOR THE INVITING SCHOOL AWARD:** This should include a diverse representative group of students, staff, families, faculty, administration, alumni, community leaders, Superintendent, Department Chair, University President or designee. If the organization submits a portfolio, this sheet should be included as part of the documentation.
3. **LETTER BY THE APPLICANTS(S):** Statement of why your school/district/university is deserving of The Inviting School Award
4. **A ONE-PAGE SHEET OF INTRODUCTION TO YOUR SCHOOL:** If a person has never seen or heard of it, what would they see, hear, taste, smell, and feel?
5. **MINIMUM OF FIVE DIVIDERS:** Please label the five dividers in the portfolio with the 5 P's of Invitational practice...**PEOPLE, PLACES, POLICIES, PROGRAMS, and PROCESSES.** Within each of these categories, the award applicant will compile the samples of strategies used within each category to tell its story of the intentional plans implemented to make its organization more inviting.
6. **RESULTS OF THE INVITING SCHOOL SURVEY:** The survey can be obtained via the IAIE website. Schools seeking the Inviting School Award need to request a login and password to access the survey.

<p>NOTE: Use your creativity and imagination to tell your story. You may wish to provide additional items for consideration, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your school/district/university's written inviting plan• Special recognition• Awards received• Training received in invitational philosophy• Inviting survey, etc.

Important Information For 2010 Inviting School Awards

It is recommended that your application include the following supporting documentation in the format of a paper portfolio and/or a CD-ROM.

The following guidelines are provided to assist your school in the process of working toward this award:

- Complete the Inviting School Survey to gain information about your school's current inviting school practices. The survey is available on-line at the IAIE website. Your school will be able to access the survey upon receipt of your Acceptance Verification Statement to the Awards Chair.
- Document initial findings from the survey and other sources of information and determine a baseline of where your school is on your invitational journey.
- Provide a statement of invitational goals – objectives – strategies based on your initial findings
- Explain your plan of action based on your established goals, objectives and
- Provide a timeline that outlines the development of your action plan as you continue on your journey
- Provide a Reflective Statement about insights you may have during or about your process
- Include site visit(s) and/or training from a specialist in invitational education, your state/regional coordinator, member of the IAIE Advisory Board, and/or an IAIE Trustee.
- Revisit the Invitational School Survey-Revised and compare your findings with your initial information
- Provide a LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION from a current member of IAIE. IAIE state/regional coordinators and advisory council members will assist in the process, if requested.

The portfolios will be taken to the World Conference and displayed for all conference attendees. The school/district/university may then take their portfolio with them when the conference ends

Process Revisited:

An important component to the Inviting School Award is the One Year Follow-Up as an effort to sustain and maintain the concepts of Invitational Education in your school. This statement should focus on three areas:

1. Where are we now that we are an "Inviting School"?
2. How we have met our Goals and Objectives?
3. What is our vision for the future?

This process should follow the Helix of Invitational Education (Purkey & Novak 1996. Inviting School Success, 3rd Edition pp. 136-137. Wadsworth Publishing Co.) as a continuing effort to sustain and maintain your school as an "Inviting School".
