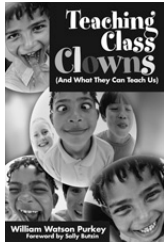

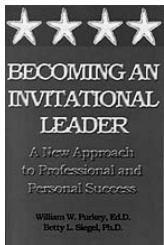

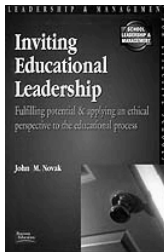
Teaching Class Clowns and What They Can Teach Us
